3. Introduction :

The Kinniya Central College is the only 1AB National school with hostel facility catering the educational need of the Muslim pupil in Trincomalee district. It has celebrated its Golden jubilee in 2008. Currently more than 2100 students are enrolled in our school from Grade 1 to grade 13.

Although it is a National school encompasses high expectation from the society, it is experiencing shortages of of Human resources physical resources as well as other Quality inputs.

Even with these deficiencies the school has been not second to any other leading school of this Island. The school has historical performances in education, sports as well as cultural activities for last several years.

#### **7.Justification:**

2. Every year we have to spend more money on transport alone. Our annual transportation cost is approximately Rs.190000 per year. That is more than 50% of the recurrent expenditures. If we able to cut

short this expense we can use this money for purchasing other quality inputs.

3. Currently Kinniya Central College is having following competitive teams which are qualifying every year almost to all levels.
